RE: NYS Executive Budget: Transportation and Economic Development - Article VII Legislation (Part Q)

Dear Governor Cuomo:

The New York Building Congress is a membership coalition composed of more than 550 constituent organizations in the design, construction and real estate industry, employing over 300,000 tradespeople and professionals in the New York region. We urge you to reconsider language in the State Budget Article VII bill which seeks to broaden mandates for MWBE participation on State projects.

Consistent with our mission of building a better New York, the Building Congress has long supported efforts to grow minority/women owned businesses. Through membership events, industry research, and support of workforce development programs, the Building Congress seeks to provide opportunities to promote the growth of MWBE firms and a diverse workforce.

However, the changes proposed in the Executive Budget, Transportation and Economic Development - Article VII Legislation (Part Q) could actually deter broad industry participation. Minority and women owned business participation could actually be discouraged by the punitive approach taken in this bill. We therefore urge this language be removed from the budget so that a more robust policy discussion can be had outside the abbreviated timeframe of the budget process.

It's critical that a healthy dialogue take place between key stakeholders to address these critical issues and increase participation of MWBE firms on State construction projects. It is my hope the Building Congress and our members will contribute to that dialogue and help achieve our shared goals.



The Building Congress strongly supports strengthening programs that develop MWBE firms, allowing them to thrive in this robust but competitive construction market. However, we ask that this effort take place outside of the State Budget process, to ensure a deliberative and lasting solution that increases MWBE participation without unfairly penalizing contractors.
