MARKET WATCH — "City's office market reporting record gains in new construction," by POLITICO New York's Sally Goldenberg: New York City's office market is the hottest it has been in decades, and commercial buildings planned for Hudson Yards and the revamped Penn Station will carry the boom into the 2020s, according to a report from the New York Building Congress. The trade organization is projecting 2.3 million square feet of new office space will be completed in Manhattan this year, followed by 7.2 million next year and 5.6 million in 2019, according to data it compiled from the Real Estate Board of New York. If the projected development stays on track, there will be 27.4 million square feet of new office space in Manhattan constructed between 2010 and 2019, making it the busiest decade since the 1980s, when 49 million square feet of new office space was built.
