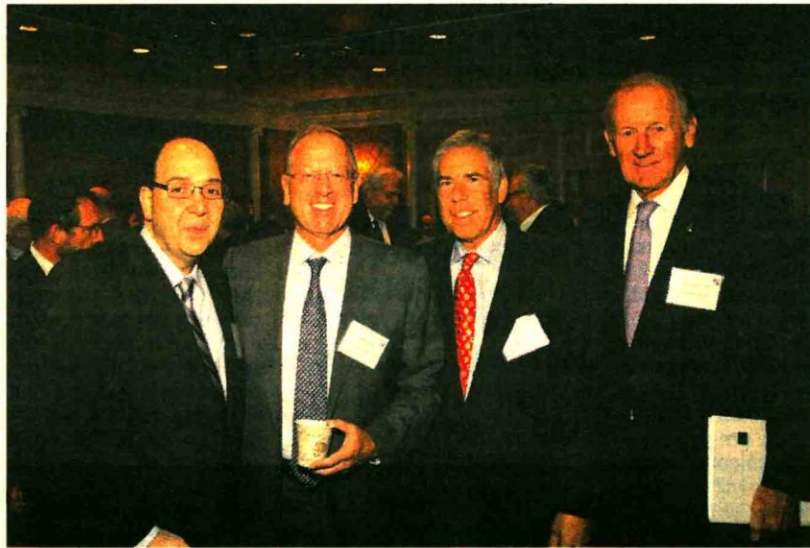

## NEW YORK BUILDING CONGRESS BREAKFAST FORUM

**T**he New York Building Congress released New York City Construction Outlook 2012-2014, its annual review and forecast, at an October 17 Construction Industry Breakfast Forum featuring New York City Deputy Mayor Robert Steel. Building Congress President Richard Anderson opened the forum by providing nearly 300 guests in attendance with a detailed presentation on the report. According to Mr. Anderson, annual construction spending is forecast to top \$30 billion for the first time since 2008 and should remain stable in 2013 and 2014. That alone, was reason enough to celebrate, as many at the event did with aplomb.
